Universal Level of Protection - Issues



■ ENGO Statement

- Source protection planning to apply to all watershed

■ TEC Report Recommendations

- No recommendations concerning watershed in north

■ IC Report Recommendations

- No proposals for north (as of yet) [p.8]

Universal Level of Protection



■ ENGO Statement

- applies to private and municipal systems

■ TEC Report

- integrated into watershed programs for the protection of all water and all water users [GP 5, 9, 10]

- Not enough emphasis on municipal systems?

■ IC Report

- Not clear

Universal Level of Protection



■ ENGO Statement

- protect ground and surface waters - from both point and non-point sources

■ TEC Report

- aquifer protection zones (TEC 58,59)
- surface water sources to be treated (36,77)
- programs for pathogen protection - private sources (TEC 123, 35, 36, 46, 47)
- Nutrient management and farm water protection

Universal Level of Protection



- IC Report

- See: Recommendations 100-102 concerning non-point sources and cumulative loading

Universal Level of Protection



■ ENGO Statement

- protect water sources - quality and quantity

■ TEC Report

- recognition of quality and quantity (GP8,10)

■ IC Report

- implementation tools deal with both water quality and quantity

Universal Level of Protection



- ENGO Statement
 - recognition of the precautionary principle
- TEC Report
 - Could not find express reference
- IC Report
 - Express recognition as guiding principle (p. 4)

Universal Level of Protection



- ENGO Statement

- MOE to remain accountable and responsible for source protection planning

- TEC Report

- apparent - could be made clearer?

- IC Report

- apparent - could be made clearer?

Appropriate Planning Scale and Scope



- ENGO Statement

- Plan by watershed with appropriate sharing of resources

- TEC Report

- See: GP 5

- IC Report

- Sufficient recognition?

Appropriate Planning Scale



- ENGO Statement protection of all waters including shorelines, wetlands, etc.
- TEC Report
 - recognition with respect to water budgets (no. 19)
 - See ENGO statement under 4.0
- IC Report
 - See implementation principles - 1 and 4

Appropriate Planning Scale



■ ENGO Statement

- recognition of groundwater -surface relationship

■ TEC Report

- water budgets make recognition
- many other instances of recognition

■ IC Report

- See implementation principles
